

Joseph and the Amazing Technicolour Dreamcoat Auditions - What to Expect

Audition dates: Thursday 22th March, Tuesday 27th March and Wednesday 28th March. 4.30pm- 6.30pm, St Patrick's College Music Dept

Thank you for considering auditioning for Joseph and the Amazing Technicolour Dreamcoat. It will be a wonderful show.

Here is what to expect at your audition.

1. Print the information form and fill it out in advance.
2. Arrive at the St. Patrick's College music room by 4:30 on your audition day.
3. You will hear a brief talk from Mr. Wood, Ms. Moran and Mr. Powdrell about the audition process.
4. A singing audition - Mr. Powdrell will check your vocal range. You will then sing a song of your choice. It doesn't have to be a song from a musical but this is recommended if you are aiming for a lead role.
5. An acting audition. This will involve 1 or 2 Improv Drama games like *Bus Stop*. You will also read from one or two short blank scripts. These two tasks will test your facial and vocal expression, confidence and ability to work in a group. The blank scripts we will use can be found on the school website to read over in advance.

If you make it through to the call-back stages, you will have one more singing audition. This will be a number from *Joseph and the Amazing Technicolour Dreamcoat* selected for you by Mr. Powdrell. He will send you the information closer to call back time.

We are looking forward to seeing you at the auditions.
